### Joshua Motta, Founder and CEO

Joshua is the CEO of Coalition. He is a technology innovator and entrepreneur, with experience in both the public and private sector. Prior to Coalition, Joshua was instrumental in the founding and growth of Cloudflare, a privately held \$2bn security company, where he was the CxO and Head of Special Projects. Cloudflare has been recognized as the Most Innovative Networking and Internet Technology Company for two-years running by the *Wall Street Journal*, and a Technology Pioneer by the World Economic Forum.

Prior to Cloudflare, Joshua spent over five years as an investor, quant and advisor in the hedge fund, private equity and banking sectors, including positions within Goldman Sachs' London-based investment banking team, and at Francisco Partners, a US\$10bn global private equity firm focused on technology.

Joshua has a deep mathematical and technical background having worked in various capacities at the Central Intelligence Agency, Honeywell and Sprint. Joshua began his career at Microsoft, where he was the company's youngest hire. Joshua holds an A.B. degree from the University of Chicago where he graduated Phi Beta Kappa.
